

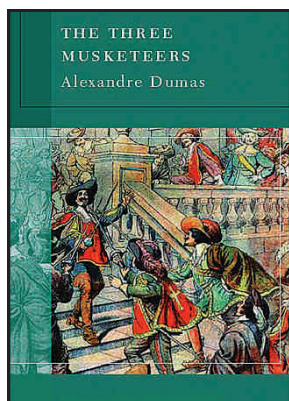
# THE READING ZONE

*The Three Musketeers* by Alexandre Dumas, although a classic tale, is one of the best books I've ever read. In

**Who inspired you to read?**

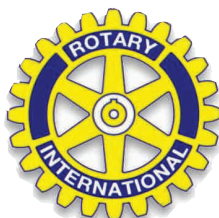
My parents inspired me to read because they had always read.
