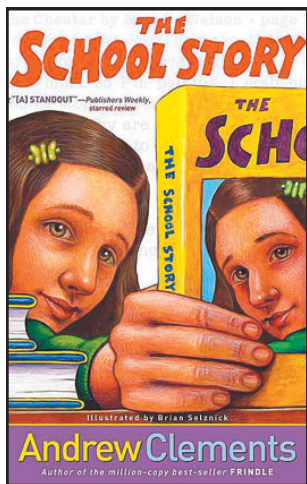
STUDENT BOOK REVIEW

The School Story

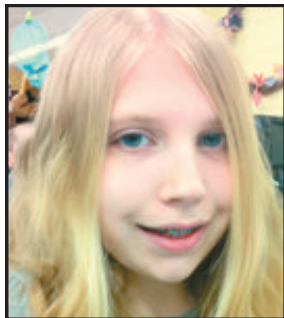
