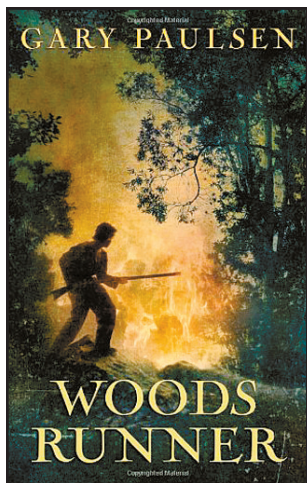

Woods Runner

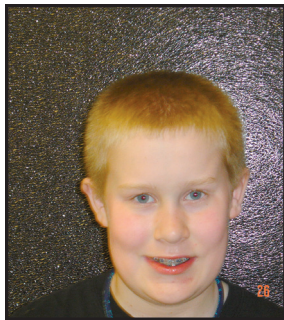
