

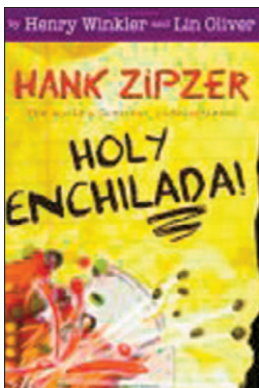
THE READING ZONE

The book *Holy Enchilada* is written by Henry Winkler and Lin Oliver. It's about a boy named Hank and his friends.

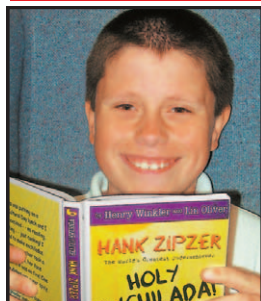
