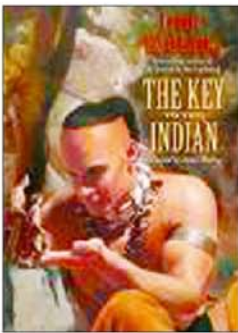
## STUDENT BOOK REVIEW
