

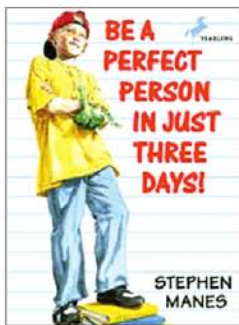
THE READING ZONE
