

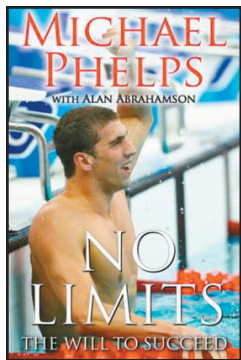

Where do you like to read?

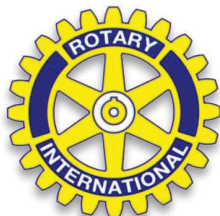
I like to read in my bed at night because it is quiet.
