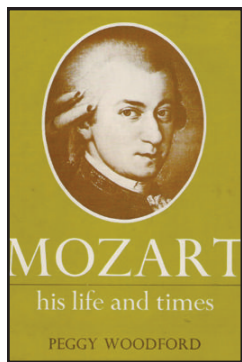
STUDENT BOOK REVIEW
