



ChroniclEdition Q&A

What is an ChroniclEdition?

An electronic edition is an EXACT REPLICA of The Chronicle-Telegram. Students can log onto any computer with internet access and flip through pages and skim headlines, just as they would with the traditional newspaper.

What are the benefits of subscribing to ChroniclEdition?

Readers can view all the text, photos, and advertisements exactly as they are printed in the daily paper, plus have the option to change the screen layout, move easily through pages and sections, and save and send articles with a click of a button. Keyword searches allow students to research any topic, person or event instantly.

Increased use of **ChroniclEdition** subscriptions will have a positive impact environmentally, as well, due to the decreased use of newsprint, and the decreased use of fuel required for delivery of print copies.

Is there a cost to ChroniclEdition subscriptions?

The Chronicle-NIE subscriptions are provided to schools at no cost. The Chronicle provides

ChroniclEdition at the educational rate of 9.25 cents each. NIE partners with local businesses that agree to help sponsor school subscriptions. In addition to business sponsors, generous subscribers donate to schools through the Vacation Donation and Block Party pages programs.

May I view a demo before I subscribe to ChroniclEdition?

Yes. Just go to the NIE home page and click on “Demo” under the log-in box.

How does ChroniclEdition subscription work?

Order forms are available on the NIE home page: <http://www.chroniclet.com/nie> OR by calling [329-7183](tel:329-7183) and asking for a hard copy to be mailed or faxed. Complete your order, and send to NIE as indicated. Your order will be processed, and NIE will email a USER ID, PASSWORD and instructions on how to access your subscription.

We require that teachers indicate on the order form HOW MANY STUDENTS will be using the **ChronicEdition**, so we will have an accurate accounting of school circulation.

Do I have to use the same USER ID number assigned by NIE, or may I change it to make it easier for me to remember?

School subscribers must use the USER IDs assigned by NIE.

Do students have to use the same computer(s) everyday?

No.

Can I use ChronicEdition outside of school?

NIE provides no-cost **ChronicEditions** for schools as an educational resource and instructional tool to enhance literacy efforts, support the classroom learning process, encourage student readership, and provide opportunities for success in school performance and homework assignments. Any access unrelated to classroom instruction is not allowed and is a violation of the NIE **ChronicEdition** program agreement.

How soon will my ChronicEdition start?

NIE will make every effort to start your subscription as soon as possible, and within no more than three days of receiving your order.

How do I log-in?

Click to enter the **ChronicEdition**, and you will be prompted to enter your USER ID and PASSWORD.

What if I cannot log-in or have trouble viewing the ChronicEdition?

How do I navigate the ChronicEdition and what features will help me maximize ChronicEdition?

A “Hot to Navigate” button is located at the top of the page.

Can I access previous ChronicEditions?

Users can access up to one full year. (Back issues are currently being archived beginning with July 08)

Can I subscribe even if I do not have computers in my classroom?

Yes. As long as you plan to use **ChronicEdition** in an educational setting as an instructional tool. For example, you and your students may use **ChronicEdition** in your classroom with a smartboard or LCD projector or computer lab, and students may work on their lessons then, and also later on a different school computer, such as the library.

Can I share ChronicEdition with another teacher?

NIE requests that you order the number you need for actual classroom use. NIE recognizes that two or three students may share one license (newspaper.) NIE must provide a reasonable accounting of how many students are actually using the **ChronicEdition**, and request that teachers assist us in being as accurate as possible.
